Aviation Scholarships deadline nearing

March 26, 2010 - To help promote the growth and continuation of aviation in Alaska the Alaska Airmen's Association offers three scholarships yearly. This year the deadline for those studying in aviation fields is on or before May 31, 2010.

The three \$2,500 scholarships available are named for Alaskans who contributed to aviation, they are the John P. Culhane Memorial Scholarship, F. Atlee Dodge Maintenance Scholarship, and the Bob Reeve Aviation Management Scholarship.

If you, a member of your family, or a friend is studying in an aviation related program with an accredited college, university, trade school, approved training center (Part 141), or in current training with a certified flight instructor or an A&P mechanic and has lived in Alaska for at least two years, are eligible to apply.

Recipients of the scholarships are required to use their funds for an aviation career in Alaska.
